   However, you are responsible for organizing and paying for your own transportation (to Orlando, and within Orlando to your hotel), lodging, and meals (other than lunch).

#### **Your hosts**

     Center to see ZDN in action during food prep
  - Ample time to talk with kitchen team, nutritionists, and managers about their usage and best practices
  - Formal training on ZDN topics
  - Assistance working on your own zoo's data and setup, guided by experienced users.
- Lunch and snacks each day
- Transport to and from the Flamingo
   Crossing hotel area to the workshop site
   daily. There is no private vehicle or
   pedestrian access to the workshop location.

## Requirements

- Attendees should be using or actively getting ready to use Zoo Diet NaviGator in some capacity at your institution (even if you are just getting started). If you are evaluating ZDN or wondering if this is for you, please join the <u>online biweekly</u> introductions instead.
- Participants should bring laptops with a current version of Zoo Diet NaviGator already installed and have access to their zoo's data (either a local copy of the datafile or ability to connect to your zoo's network from a remote location.
